#### **OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS**

The End of Program Survey (EOPS) responses met or exceeded both the acceptable and ideal targets. The survey's results were based on responses specific to the following items: the curriculum was relevant to my professional needs and I understand the learning objectives of my courses.

Overall, it is recommended that Faculty review each 2014-15 assessment plan (including measures and targets set) in preparation for the 2015-16 assessment cycles.
