 Waypoint, CPC Exam sections, and all survey measures to ensure that these targets remain appropriate and meaningful.
- The PLOs for BAAC did change this Academic Year, which should be considered when planning changes.
- The PLO changes are not reflected everywhere on the assessment website for 15-16 as they occurred mid-year, but will for the 16-17 year.
