

# CDW Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Effective 09/01/2023



**1. ELIGIBILITY:** CDW and the University of Arizona Global Campus (UAGC) (“Program Entities”) will offer up to five (5) scholarships to UAGC (the “CDW Scholarship”). The CDW Scholarship opportunity is open only to the CDW employees that meet the requirements outlined below (the “Eligibility Requirements”).

- All applicants must be able to meet UAGC admission requirements as outlined in the UAGC Academic Catalog for applicable degree program level as well as meet all applicable international requirements by September 29, 2023 (11:59 p.m. PT); see below for applicable admission requirements.

- Inability to meet requirements for admission in their entirety by September 29, 2023 (11:59 p.m. PT) will result in disqualification from the scholarship selection.
- Applicants cannot be currently enrolled in UAGC (“Current UAGC Students”) when applying for the CDW Scholarship. Current UAGC Students are not eligible to complete an application or receive the CDW Scholarship.
- Recipients must reside in a state where UAGC programs are available. Certain UAGC degree programs and emphases may not be available in all states. Laws and participation vary from state to state and participation in this program in the states of Arkansas, Minnesota, Massachusetts, North Carolina, Washington, D.C., New York, Rhode Island, and Puerto Rico is limited. Prospective applicants should call UAGC at 855-805-6911 for more details regarding program availability.
- Applicants must be employed by CDW for at least six (6) continuous months, but no more than three (3) years of continuous tenure, with no corrective action at the close of the CDW Scholarship Opportunity Application Period and at time of scholarship selection.

**2. HOW TO APPLY:** The CDW Scholarship Application Period starts on September 18, 2023, at 12:00 a.m. PT and ends at 11:59 p.m. PT on September 29, 2023 (the “Application Period”). The scholarship recipient(s) (“Recipient”) will be announced by October 13, 2023 (the “Recipient Announcement Date”). The CDW Scholarship is subject to these Terms and Conditions. By submitting an application each applicant confirms they meet the Eligibility Requirements and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in these Terms and Conditions. To apply for a scholarship visit the CDW Scholarship [landing page](#) during the Application Period and follow the instructions for submitting the CDW Scholarship Application (the “Application”). The University of Arizona Global Campus computer will be the official time clock for the program.

**3. RECIPIENT SELECTION:** On the Recipient Announcement Date, finalists will be selected at random via computer selection. The finalists will have ten (10) business days after they are notified of their selection to verify they are able to meet UAGC admission requirements. Failure to meet UAGC admission requirements by October 27, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. PT will result in disqualification and the applicant will not proceed to final selection. During the week of October 30, 2023, up to five (5) Recipients will be selected at random from the approved finalists. Selection decisions are final and binding in all respects. Alternate Recipients may be selected in the event initial Recipients decline the scholarship or are disqualified.

**4. RECIPIENT VERIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION:** Recipients are subject to verification. Recipients must reside in a state with available UAGC programs and meet all Eligibility requirements outlined above (See #1. Eligibility). The selected Recipients will be notified by UAGC and CDW by phone and email during the week of October 30, 2023. If a selected Recipient is unreachable by phone after reasonable attempts have been made to contact such selected Recipient during a period of seven (7) business days, or if a notification is returned as undeliverable, the selected Recipient may be disqualified. The selected Recipients will be required to complete and return the CDW Scholarship Acknowledgement, Waiver, and Release form prior to starting courses. Failure to sign and return all required documents within the specified time period may result in forfeiture and disqualification of the selected Recipient and an Alternate Recipient may be selected. Specified time periods may be extended up to thirty (30) additional business days should an Alternate Recipient be selected.

**5. SCHOLARSHIP:** A total of up to five (5) scholarships will be awarded. Each award consists of: (a) full program tuition ([approved Bachelor's and Master's degree programs](#)), (b) books and course digital materials (CDM) credit for the entire program, (c) Technology Fee waivers for the entire program, (d) Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) Fee waiver, and (e) Graduation Fee waiver for the pursuit of an online Bachelor's or Master's degree from the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the UAGC Academic Catalog, including without limitation all UAGC admission requirements. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL TAXES, AND ANY OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES, ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH RECIPIENT. The scholarships are awarded WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or implied, without limitation. If a Recipient chooses not to accept their scholarship, an Alternate Recipient may be chosen. The approximate retail value of the scholarship will vary depending on the UAGC tuition rate, program level, and specific degree program but is estimated to be between \$23,100 and \$70,950. Any taxes on the scholarship value are the sole responsibility of the Recipients. Scholarships consist only of items expressly specified in these Terms and Conditions. Any costs or expenses associated with the acceptance or use of any scholarship (including, without limitation, transcript fees, living expenses, and graduation regalia) are the responsibility of the Recipients. No substitution or transfer of the scholarship or the right to receive the scholarship is permitted, except that UAGC may in its discretion substitute for any scholarship an alternate scholarship of equal or greater value.

**6. CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:** The scholarship award will be granted to the Recipients in the form of a non-cash credit to UAGC, and no check or cash payments will be given and/or refunded to any Recipient at any time. Recipients must remain actively employed by CDW to continue to receive the CDW Scholarship. Recipients who cease employment with CDW should contact CDW for policy regarding repayment of any CDW funds towards the CDW Scholarship. Recipients may NOT receive any federal financial aid, including but not limited to

Pell Grants and Direct Loans, in any form while participating in the CDW Scholarship. Recipients must enroll in their program of choice within 90 calendar days following the award date or forfeit the scholarship award. Scholarship recipients found to be in violation of the Student Community Standards at any time during their enrollment with the University of Arizona Global Campus risk revocation of any scholarship awarded, at the sole discretion of the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the University of Arizona Global Campus Academic Catalog, including without limitation the University of Arizona Global Campus admission requirements, Satisfactory Academic Progress (including, maintaining a 2.00 GPA for Bachelor's programs and 3.00 GPA for Master's programs), and Attendance. The scholarship recipients must remain continuously enrolled or on an approved academic leave during their enrollment to maintain scholarship eligibility. Scholarship recipients who are out of attendance greater than 180 consecutive days will forfeit the scholarship award. Recipients cannot receive any other institutional offers or grants.

**7. PERSONAL INFORMATION:** Information collected via the Application shall be subject to the University of Arizona Global Campus privacy policy, which can be viewed at <https://www.uagc.edu/privacy/>. Applicants acknowledge that representatives of the University of Arizona Global Campus may contact them about enrollment opportunities at the University of Arizona Global Campus and/or may contact Applicants with future communications and offers.

**8. MISCELLANEOUS:** All Applicants release all of the Program Entities, and all others associated with the development and execution of this CDW Scholarship, from any and all claims and liabilities arising from or in connection with participation in this CDW Scholarship, the delivery, non-delivery, acceptance or use of any scholarship and/or the use of the Applicant's submitted application as permitted hereunder, including without limitation claims for injury, death, loss or damage of any kind. This CDW Scholarship is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The University of Arizona Global Campus is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, corrupted, mutilated, misdirected, misdelivered, undelivered, blocked or delayed entries or other communications, or for technical or human errors, delays or failures of any kind in connection with the submission, transmission, processing, storage or judging of entries, including without limitation any malfunctions or failures of computer hardware, computer software, networks or telephone equipment, any data loss or corruption, or any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. The University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to suspend and/or modify the CDW Scholarship, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the University of Arizona Global Campus reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the CDW Scholarship. This determination will be made by the University of Arizona Global Campus in consultation with CDW. If the fraud, technical failures, and/or other factors impairing the integrity or proper functioning of the CDW Scholarship cannot be resolved within a reasonable period of time, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to cancel the CDW Scholarship. In the event of cancellation, suspension or modification of the CDW Scholarship, a notice will be posted online. Failure by the University of Arizona Global Campus to enforce any term of these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. The Program Entities will not be liable to any Applicant or any other person for failure to supply any scholarship or any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts,

earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the control of the Program Entities. Applicants acknowledge that the Program Entities have neither made nor are in any manner responsible for any warranty, representation or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, related to the scholarship award. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN APPLICANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CDW SCHOLARSHIP IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA GLOBAL CAMPUS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. Without limitation of the foregoing, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual Applicant who tampers with the entry process. **10. DISPUTES:** This program is governed by the laws of the state of Arizona without giving effect to conflict of law doctrines. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will any Applicant be permitted to obtain an award of, and hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g. costs associated with entering), and each Applicant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
