

CVS Health Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Effective 01/14/2022



OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING. THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** CVS Health and the University of Arizona Global Campus ("Program Entities") offer the CVS Health & University of Arizona Global Campus (UAGC) Scholarship (the "CVS Scholarship Program"). The CVS Scholarship Program is open only to the following: CVS Health and MinuteClinic colleagues ("employees"). All federal, state and local rules and regulations apply. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
- 2. HOW TO ENTER:** The CVS Scholarship Program starts on 1/31/2022 and ends at 11:59 pm (Pacific Time) on 2/25/2022 (the "Entry Period"). Winners will be announced by 3/7/2022 (the "Winner Announcement Date"). The CVS Scholarship Program is subject to these official rules ("Official Rules"). By entering, all applicants ("Applicants") agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in these Official Rules. Certain restrictions may apply. To enter, visit the CVS Health Scholarship [landing page](#) during the Entry Period and follow the entry instructions. Applicants will be required to submit the CVS Health Scholarship Application (the "Application"). The University of Arizona Global Campus computer will be the official time clock for the program. Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. In the event of a dispute as to the ownership of an entry, the authorized account holder of the email address used to submit an entry will be deemed to be the Applicant. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. The potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder. Multiple entries will not increase chances of being selected. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 11:59 PM (Pacific Time) ON THE LAST DAY OF THE ENTRY PERIOD TO BE ELIGIBLE.** When you apply for the CVS Scholarship Program, you may be asked to consent to receive promotional emails and reminders for promotions and information about online education. Consenting to receive such emails is optional and is not a requirement for participation in the CVS Scholarship Program and does not improve your chances of winning. Entry must be made by the Applicant only via the Application. Entries made by any other individual or any entity and/or originating at any other Internet website or email address will be void. The use of any device, hardware and/or computer software to automate the entry process is prohibited.
- 3. WINNER SELECTION:** A total of up to five (5) winners will be selected via a random lottery by 3/7/2022. Selection decisions are final and binding in all respects. Alternate winners may be selected in the event potential winners decline the scholarship or are disqualified.
- 4. WINNER VERIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION:** Potential winners are subject to verification. The selected winners will be notified by UAGC and/or Zovio Inc (third-party service provider for

UAGC) and CVS Health by phone and email, by 3/7/2022. If a selected winner is unreachable by phone after reasonable attempts have been made to contact such selected winner during a period of seven (7) business days, or if a notification is returned as undeliverable, the selected winner may be disqualified. The selected winner will be required to complete and return the CVS Health Scholarship Acknowledgement, Waiver and Release form prior to starting courses. Failure to sign and return all required documents within the specified time period may result in forfeiture and disqualification of the selected winner and an alternate winner may be selected. Specified time periods may be extended up to thirty (30) additional business days should an alternate winner be selected.

5. **SCHOLARSHIP:** A total of up to five (5) scholarships will be awarded. The award consists of: (a) full program tuition (Bachelor's or Master's degree program), (b) books and CDM credit for the entire program, (c) Technology Fee waiver for the entire program, (d) Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) Fee waiver, and (e) Graduation Fee waiver for the pursuit of an online degree from the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the UAGC Academic Catalog, including without limitation all UAGC admission requirements. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL TAXES, AND ANY OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES, ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH WINNER. The scholarships are awarded WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or implied, without limitation. If a Winner chooses not to accept his/her scholarship, an alternate winner may be chosen. The approximate retail value of the scholarship will vary depending on the UAGC tuition rate, program level, and specific degree program but is estimated to be between \$23,100 and \$70,950. Any taxes on the scholarship value are the sole responsibility of the winner. Scholarships consist only of items expressly specified in these rules. Any costs or expenses associated with the acceptance or use of any scholarship (including, without limitation, transcript fees, living expenses, and graduation regalia) are the responsibility of the winner. No substitution or transfer of the scholarship or the right to receive the scholarship is permitted, except that UAGC may in its discretion substitute for any scholarship an alternate scholarship of equal or greater value.

6. **CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:** The scholarship award will be granted to the Winners in the form of a non-cash credit to UAGC, and no check or cash payments will be given and/or refunded to any Winner at any time. Winners may not receive any federal financial aid, including but not limited to Pell Grants and Direct Loans, in any form while participating in the CVS Scholarship Program. Winners must enroll in their program of choice within 60 calendar days following the award date or forfeit the scholarship award. Scholarship recipients found to be in violation of the Student Community Standards at any time during their enrollment with the University of Arizona Global Campus risk revocation of any scholarship awarded, at the sole discretion of the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the University of Arizona Global Campus Academic Catalog, including without limitation the University of Arizona Global Campus admission requirements, Satisfactory Academic Progress, and Attendance. The scholarship recipients must remain continuously enrolled or on an approved academic leave during his/her enrollment to maintain scholarship eligibility. Scholarship recipients who are out of attendance greater than 180 consecutive days will forfeit the scholarship award.

7. **GENERAL RULES:** All Applicants release all of the Program Entities, and all others associated with the development and execution of this CVS Scholarship Program, from any and all claims and liabilities arising from or in connection with participation in this CVS Scholarship Program, the

delivery, non-delivery, acceptance or use of any scholarship and/or the use of the Applicant's submitted application as permitted hereunder, including without limitation claims for injury, death, loss or damage of any kind. This CVS Scholarship Program is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The University of Arizona Global Campus is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, corrupted, mutilated, misdirected, misdelivered, undelivered, blocked or delayed entries or other communications, or for technical or human errors, delays or failures of any kind in connection with the submission, transmission, processing, storage or judging of entries, including without limitation any malfunctions or failures of computer hardware, computer software, networks or telephone equipment, any data loss or corruption, or any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. The University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to suspend and/or modify the CVS Scholarship Program, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the University of Arizona Global Campus reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the CVS Scholarship Program. This determination will be made by the University of Arizona Global Campus in consultation with CVS. If the fraud, technical failures, and or other factors impairing the integrity or proper functioning of the CVS Scholarship Program cannot be resolved within a reasonable period of time, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to cancel the CVS Scholarship Program. In the event of cancellation, suspension or modification of the CVS Scholarship Program, a notice will be posted online. Failure by the University of Arizona Global Campus to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. The Program Entities will not be liable to any Applicant or any other person for failure to supply any scholarship or any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the control of the Program Entities. Applicants acknowledge that the Program Entities have neither made nor are in any manner responsible for any warranty, representation or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, related to the scholarship award. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN APPLICANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CVS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA GLOBAL CAMPUS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. Without limitation of the foregoing, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual Applicant who tampers with the entry process. 10. DISPUTES: This program is governed by the laws of the state of Arizona without giving effect to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in this program, each Applicant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with this program, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in the State of Arizona having jurisdiction, unless otherwise provided in agreements between the Applicant and the University of Arizona Global Campus. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will any Applicant be permitted to obtain an award of, and hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g. costs associated with entering), and each Applicant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
