Submission Instructions for Faculty

Prior to submitting the incident report, instructors should take the following steps:

- If the alleged violation of academic integrity is based on a <u>Turnitin report</u>, please **verify the accuracy of the report**. This includes indicating the passages identified by the report, which were improperly documented by the student or are determined to be a resubmission of previously submitted academic work by the student.
- Per the <u>Reuse of Previously Submitted Academic Work Policy</u>, submissions of previously submitted academic work should be managed within the classroom. Grading is up to instructor discretion on the reuse of previously submitted work.
- If the paper appears to be pulled from a paper-mill like site such as Course Hero, provide the link to the paper from the website.
- Please note that a submission of IROAD does not guarantee that the student will receive a citation for an academic
 integrity policy violation from the institution. The Academic Integrity team investigates each incident and is the final
 determination of whether or not a citable offense has occurred. In the event that the incident is determined to not be a
 citable offense, faculty will be contacted to inform them of the decision and next steps to assess the student's submitted
 work.
- Students may be provided an opportunity to give their perspective on the referred assignment(s) prior to issuance of a citation.
- If the alleged violation of academic integrity is based on Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI), please review the <u>Artificial</u> Intelligence Review Checklist and proceed accordingly.
